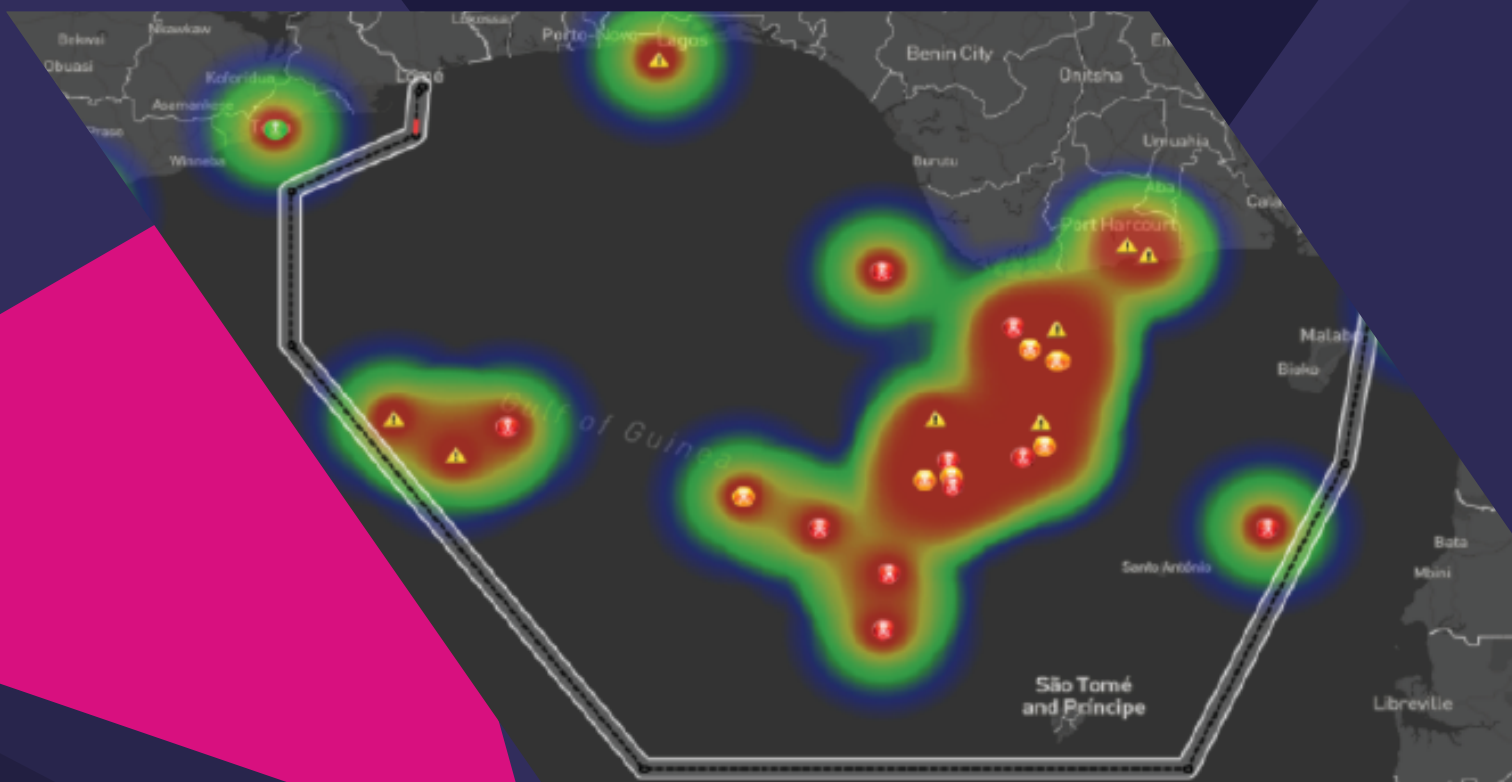

Route Risk Reports

Clearwater Dynamics Route Risk Reports (RRRs) provide a clear overview of the latest incidents posing a potential security risk relevant to a vessels imminent voyage.



Improve domain awareness

Accurate and factual information produced by Clearwater's intelligence services is trusted by Government Navies and industry governing authorities. Utilising this information to generate RRRs enhances domain awareness for ship masters and CSOs, facilitating risk mitigation for each voyage.

How does it work?

STEP 1

Vessel Master sends an email to Clearwater with notification of intended voyage and provides route waypoints from ECDIS

STEP 2

Provided route is uploaded to the Clearwater Web Portal by an Operations Officer

STEP 3

Clearwater Operations Officer analyses the planned route for any recent and geographically relevant security incidents

STEP 4

Completed analyses provided via Route Risk Report in PDF format sent to vessel Master and CSO

What's included ?

Standard Route Risk Reports

- Visual route overview
- List of alerts within 250nm of the intended route over the past 31 days

In-depth Route Risk Reports

- Description of route overview and historic piracy activity within a timeframe specified by the client
- Image of the route
- List of waypoints
- Vessels particulars
- BMP5 compliance table
- Day by day breakdown of the intended route and description of alerts along the route within 250nm
- Environmental factors – sea state, sunrise/sunset, moonrise/moonset
- General risk table – day by day overview of risk
- Summary of the area the vessel is voyaging with recommendations
